Anthem Health Plans, Inc. – Individual – On and Off Exchange

Rate request – Average increase of 9.8 percent Decision – Under Review

Public Comment Period: Begins June 9, 2023 and will remain open for 30 days or until the filing is closed, whichever is later

On June 1, 2023, Anthem Health Plans, Inc. filed a rate request for an average 9.8 percent increase on individual health plans marketed on and off the state's health insurance exchange.

There are approximately 33,939 people covered in Connecticut under these Anthem plans, both on and off the exchange.

The company's price calculation does account for a 9.5 percent impact of medical cost inflation, provider contracting changes and increased demand for those medical services, a factor known as "trend."

According to Anthem, the key factors of the price calculation are:

- Morbidity: There are anticipated changes in the market-wide morbidity of the covered population in the projection period.
- Benefit modifications, including changes made to comply with updated Actuarial Value requirements.
- Changes in taxes and fees, and some non-benefit expenses.
- Potential impact of proposed legislation (S.B. 6 and/or H.B. 6617) has not been included but should be if either or both pass.

If approved the new rates take effect on January 1, 2024.
